

LOL Table Captain Selection

Shared Leadership: Apprenticing is what we call the function of empowering a table member to become a table captain. Small Group Members make the best small group facilitators.

1. Apprenticing confirms gifts and talents in others.
2. A table captain can help bear some of the burden for the table leader.

Apprenticing Steps

- Intercede: Pray that God will raise up leaders in your group
 - Identify: Ask a simple question: “Who would I want to lead if I was absent?” Key characteristics to look for:
 - a desire to grow as a Christian and a desire and giftedness to connect with facilitators
 - the ability to keep themselves and their group members organized
 - they should be leaders who are good critical thinkers and problems solvers
 - they must be responsible and able to follow up and follow through by making contacts with their facilitators
- Additional Qualifications**
- Life on Life member for 2 years with consistent attendance
 - Must be recommended by a current facilitator or member of the leadership team
 - Final approval for table captain is subject to leadership observing candidate leading a table discussion
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- Invite: Talk to the group member outside of group about his/her interest in leading a group in the future and serving as your apprentice
 - Apply: The group member will need to fill out a Table Facilitator application and turn it in to the LOL leadership team.
 - Invest: Once this person has been cleared for service, begin to share leadership with your table captain (facilitating, prayer times, organizing, etc.)
