The key verse there is 16 but go ahead and read the entire chapter because reading the bible is always a good thing. Always. When you actually think through the agonizing details of the crucifixion, you can't help but realize that only a loving Father would go through such suffering for His children. Yes, He did this for everyone collectively but He's a personal God so He actually did this for YOU. His love is amazing.

Have you ever found yourself wondering if God REALLY loves you? Do you wonder if He fully understands the hardships you're facing? Do you wonder if He's so busy blessing others that you and your concerns fell through the cracks? Do you think about your problems and heartaches and figure there's no way God can love you like He says He does and allow you to struggle so much? Do you think that maybe He DOES love you, but not as much as your friend who seems to be up to their neck in blessings and favor? Listen to me dear sister. There's no doubt that God loves Him some YOU. I really need you to trust me on this one. It's important to remember that God's love for us doesn't always look like love in the movies or in romance novels. We can't fully comprehend His love and how it plays out in space and time. 1 Corinthians 13:4 does shed some light though on God's love definition. We read that "love is patient and kind: love does not envy or boast: it is not arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way: it is not irritable or resentful: it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth." That's the ESV version. Again . . . read it, write it down, hang it up and don't forget it. If you need some more reassurance (and there's NO SHAME in that.... we all need a little reassurance from time to time) make a visit to Romans 8:38-39. God in heaven adores YOU and there's not one thing that can change that. Not. One. Thing.

So maybe you're wondering WHY God loves you so. I mean, maybe you've made a few mistakes here and there. (Let's be honest. We've all made mistakes from time to time.) Maybe you feel like you don't even deserve GOD's great love. Maybe you feel like you've fallen short so many times that you only deserve a portion of the love God has to give. Listen. I'm going to share something with you, and I hope you never ever forget it. Ever. If you happen to already know this interesting bit of great truth, do me a favor and share it with as many people as you can. Here it goes. (Deep breath) Nobody DESERVES His love. Not one of us does. But He still gives it FREELY. Romans 3:23 basically says that we're all sinners and don't live up to GOD's perfect standard, but then verse 24 says that we're justified by His grace as a gift through Jesus Christ who acts as our redeemer. It's a gift, and He makes it available to all. That means that He makes it available to YOU. I paraphrased so be sure to read it for yourself. It's our faith in Jesus Christ as GOD's son and Lord of our lives that allows us to be able to receive this great gift.

I also want you to realize that if you're ever doubting GOD's love for you or the truth that He deeply cares about you, those thoughts are probably coming from the enemy, and we all know that he's a total liar. If you begin to doubt God's love for you, remind yourself by reading Ephesians 2:10.

Did you already know all of this? Did you just need a little reminder? Perhaps this information was brand spanking new to you, or maybe you're somewhere in-between. Either way, are you wondering what to do with this information now? Well, that's easy. Embrace it. Remember it. Remind yourself of it. Write a note to yourself about it and stick it on your mirror or windshield or both. And by all means, tell others about it. More people need to know that there's a GOD in heaven who loves us all more than we can comprehend. There are people who need to know that Jesus Christ loved us all the way to the cross. So, if you're gifting chocolates or paper hearts this Valentine's Day, be sure to include the gift of God's great love. It could be a word of encouragement. It could be helping someone with a project, a non-judgmental listening ear or just plain old sharing the gospel . . . that Jesus is Lord and He died to save us all. Let's all simply share the love of God.
