### Learn Something New

As a kid in the Evans household, I never wanted to disappoint my dad because I valued our relationship, but I also didn't want to be reprimanded for my actions because of the pain! I quickly realized that doing things my own way without first getting instructions from my father was not a good idea. I learned that respecting my dad while skipping his instruction was not respecting him at all. True respect and true reverence for my father would mean going to him upfront and receiving the knowledge I needed to apply to things appropriately. When I began to operate this way, people would say, "For a young kid, you are wise beyond your years." However, I knew on the inside that I was just a regular kid with a very wise father.

### Bottom Line

Many people will claim that they have a fear or respect for their Father in heaven while they simultaneously skip his instructions. Yet if you fear God, He will become the beginning of all of your knowledge. He will be FIRST. And then people will say to you that, "You are wise beyond your years."

But that's when you can reply, "I am just a kid with a very wise Father."
