General Information

What are the dates and times for the DFJ Women's Conference?

DFJ will be held on *Friday*, *July 26 from 7:00 to 8:30 pm and Saturday*, *July 27 from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm*. Check-in will begin at *5:30 pm on Friday* and at *7:30 am on Saturday*. The Conference times are in the Central Daytime zone (CDT). Click on the <u>time zone converter</u> to determine your location viewing time.

Where will the DFJ Women's Conference be held?

The conference is held at *Oak Cliff Bible Fellowship, 1660 W. Camp Wisdom Road in Dallas, Texas*. The conference will also be available via simulcast for those who can't attend in person.

What is the cost of attending the DFJ Conference in person?

The cost is **\$50 per person** for adults and teen girls to attend the two-day conference. Lunch is provided from Honey Baked Ham for an additional \$15 and must be purchased in advance. There will also be Food Trucks onsite as additional options for purchasing meals.

Is there a cost to attend the DFJ Conference virtually?

The cost to watch the conference Simulcast is \$30 for individuals/small groups (up to 10 people) and \$130 for churches/large groups (more than 10 people). Simulcast registrants will receive an email confirmation with the details to access the conference on Thursday, July 25, 2024.

What is the attire?

The attire is casual and comfortable. You may consider bringing a wrap as the auditorium will be air-conditioned.

Will refunds be offered if I can't attend DFJ in person or watch the conference virtually?

Registration payments are non-refundable for both in-person and simulcast attendance.

If you registered for the in-person conference and are unable to attend, you have two options:

- You will receive a link to watch the conference via live simulcast.
- You may transfer your in-person registration to another individual by forwarding them your email confirmation.

If I registered for the DFJ Conference and cannot attend, can I give my email confirmation ticket to someone else? Yes. However, the lunch selection *cannot* change.

In-Person Conference Registration

Who should register for the DFJ Women's Conference?

The conference is open to all women, and we encourage you to bring teenagers entering grades 6 – 12 in the fall. Childcare will be available on **Saturday only** for 6 Months – entering 5th grade in the Fall of 2024. *The cost is \$15 per child.*

Is group registration available for the In-Person Conference?

Yes. You can register a maximum of 50 women. There will be an automatic 10% discount applied to registered groups of 20.

Will I receive a confirmation of my registration?

Yes. You will receive an email confirming your registration immediately after your purchase. (Check your Spam/Junk mail if you do not receive the link in your inbox.)

Do I have to attend the entire conference?

You have the freedom to pick the sessions you attend, but attending the event in its entirety will help you to get the most out of the experience.

Will refunds be offered if I can't attend?

Registration payments are **non-refundable for the in-person conference**. If you registered for the in-person conference but can't attend, you will receive a link to watch the live-stream conference. Or you can give your email confirmation to another person, and they can attend the event under your name.

Virtual Conference Registration

Who should register for the DFJ Simulcast?

DFJ is designed for women of all ages and seasons of life. The simulcast option is available for anyone unable to attend in person.

Viewing Options:

- Individual/Household Viewing Includes live viewing access and access for replays until 11:59 pm CDT on Saturday, August 31, 2024.
- Group/Church Viewing Includes live viewing access, a Simulcast Host Guide, Customizable Promotional Materials, and access to replays until 11:59 pm CDT on Saturday, August 31, 2024.

Is group registration available?

Yes. Small group viewing for up to 10 viewers is available for \$30. Church or large group viewing of more than 10 women is available for \$130. To enhance your experience, church or large group leaders will receive a **Simulcast Host Guide** and **Customizable Promotional Materials**.

Will I receive a confirmation email?

Simulcast registrants will receive an email confirmation with the details to access the conference on *Thursday*, *July* 25, 2024.

Do I have to attend the entire simulcast conference?

Viewing via Simulcast brings the experience of an in-person conference to your computer or mobile device. Similar to the inperson conference, you can pick the sessions you attend. We encourage you to watch the full conference, to help you get the most out of the experience. You can re-watch sessions until 11:59 pm CDT on Saturday, August 31, 2024.

What time zones are streamed sessions shown?

The Desperate for Jesus Conference is broadcast from Dallas, Texas. The sessions streamed will follow the Central Daylight Time Zone (CDT). You may use a <u>time zone converter</u> to determine what time to view from your location.

What technology do I need to attend the Simulcast?

For the best experience, we suggest using a desktop, laptop computer, mobile device, or tablet with the Chrome Internet Browser. If you do not already have Chrome, <u>download it free here</u>. Please ensure that your operating systems and web browsers are updated before viewing. Additionally, a reliable high-speed internet connection is required.

Are there recordings available after the event?

As a <u>simulcast</u> registrant, you will have access to the re-broadcast of the conference until 11:59 p.m. CDT on Saturday, August 31, 2024. Email info@tonyevans.org if you have additional questions about your virtual simulcast ticket purchase.

Conference Features

What is on the program?

Program details are not available at this time. However, our planning team has prayed and planned a program with you in mind, so we ask that you and your teen girls attend the entire two-day event.

Will there be a special program at the Conference for teen girls, grades 6-12?

No. The teen girls will join the adults in the auditorium on Friday and Saturday.

Is there a program for my children?

Our children's ministry has planned exciting programming to engage your children on **Saturday only**, ages 6 Months – entering 5th grade in the fall of 2024. The cost is **\$15 per child** and must be paid for during registration. The registration will include lunch and two snacks at no additional charge. **Check-in on Saturday begins at 8:00 am.**

Will there be merchandise vendors?

Yes. A variety of vendors will sell clothing, accessories, home goods, and much more!

Will lunch be provided?

Yes. A box lunch from Honey Baked Ham at an additional cost of \$15 during your registration. Food trucks will also be available on both days of the conference.

Seating & Sign Interpretation

Is there reserved seating?

There are no reserved seats. Seating is on a first-come, first-seated basis.

Will there be wheelchair-accessible seating?

Yes. Please let the ushers know you need assistance with the wheelchair-accessible seating area.

Will there be a sign interpreter?

If you require sign interpretation, please indicate so when registering. The conference will provide a sign interpreter based on need.

Is there a church shuttle service to/from hotels?

No. OCBF will not provide a shuttle service.

Frequently Asked Questions – FAQ NextGen Kids Care

Will childcare be provided on both days of the conference?

There will be no childcare on Friday. Childcare will be provided on Saturday only and check-in begins at 8:00a.

What are the ages/grades for childcare?

• Nursery: 6 months – 2 years

• Preschool: 3 – 5 years

• Elementary: 1st to entering 5th grade in the Fall of 2024

Where will I take my child on Saturday morning for childcare?

All children will be checked in at Education Center located at 1821 West Camp Wisdom Road, Dallas TX 75232.

Can my younger child accompany an older sibling?

Having younger children with older children disrupts staffing ratios, can be more stressful for the younger child, and is generally inappropriate for care. When able, we accommodate the wishes of the parent/guardian when the request does not disrupt the overall program.

How do you ensure the safety of the children in your care?

We have developed a thorough, multi-level security process designed to ensure a seamless and controlled transition of custody from family to caregiver and back to family. The process includes registration, check-in, group assignment by ratio, and a two-adult supervision rule at all times. There is also a security presence throughout all locations when children are in our care.

For the safety of children attending the conference, it is the policy of OCBF that the adult who checks the child in **MUST** be the one who checks the child out. If the parent or guardian cannot be reached via text or a phone call, a team member will notify DFJ Conference personnel.

All NextGen Kids team members are screened through the process of a background check, as well as safety training.

How do I check in my child?

Please be aware that there will be **NO CHILDCARE provided on Friday evening**. A NextGen Kids team member will assist with the check-in process on Saturday morning beginning at 8:00 a.m. You will receive two printed labels at check-in: the child's nametag and one pick-up tag for the parent or guardian.

What if my child experiences separation anxiety?

Parents are welcome to help their children settle in if they become anxious. If a child continues to be anxious after you leave, a NextGen Kids Team member will immediately attend to your child.

What if my child becomes ill during the conference?

If your child becomes ill or injured while in our care, you will be contacted immediately by the NextGen Ministry Medical team or NextGen Staff Representative.

What if my child needs me during the conference?

If your child needs you during the conference for any reason, we will send you a text message.

What should I bring to the nursery?

Parents are asked to provide a small bag with anything their child will need during their visit with us. All items, including bottles, pacifiers, clothes, blankets, etc. should be labeled.

Will my child be fed?

Yes, children will receive breakfast, lunch, and a snack.

Can you accommodate my child's special dietary needs?

Yes! Please indicate any dietary restrictions/food allergies on your child's registration, and we will work to ensure that food options are available to meet your child's needs.
