

NextGen Check-In Details

Before You Arrive

Parents and guardians should park in the main parking areas and walk their children or students into the Education Center for check-in.

Parking near the Education Center is available on a first-come, first-served basis. We encourage parents and guardians to walk in with their children or students to help ensure a smooth and secure check-in experience.

Nursery, Preschool & Elementary

For Nursery, Preschool, and NextGen Kids Elementary, parents or guardians will check children in at one of the available kiosks.

After check-in, you will receive:

- A name tag for your child
- A matching pick-up tag for the parent or guardian

Your child must wear their name tag before entering their ministry area. Because printed name tags are required, check-in is not available through the app.

After receiving both tags, you may walk your child to their designated classroom or ministry space.

Kids Check-In Times

- For the 8:00 AM service, children are welcomed into ministry areas beginning at 7:30 AM.
- For the 11:00 AM service, children are welcomed into ministry areas beginning at 10:30 AM.

Kiosks may open earlier, but children are accepted into ministry areas 30 minutes before service.

Kids Check-Out

After service, parents and guardians should return to the same area where they dropped off their child.

Where you drop off is where you pick up.

Please have your matching pick-up tag ready so our team can safely release your child to you.

Middle School Youth

Middle school students must be checked in by a parent or legal guardian.

Middle school students must also be checked out in person by a parent or legal guardian from the designated check-out area, either Gym A or the Chapels.

For safety, middle school students may not leave the building on their own or tell leaders that a parent is waiting outside.

NextGen Check-In Details

Youth Check-In Times

- For the 8:00 AM service, youth check-in opens at 7:00 AM.
- For the 11:00 AM service, youth check-in opens at 10:00 AM.

Because all youth are required to wear a name tag, youth check-in must be completed in person and is not available through the app.

High School Youth

High school students may check themselves in and out.

High school students are still required to check in and wear a name tag while participating in NextGen Youth.

Important Safety Reminders

- Parents and guardians must walk children and middle school students into the Education Center.
- There is no curbside drop-off for NextGen ministries.
- Name tags are required for kids and youth.
- App check-in is not available because printed name tags are needed.
- Middle school students must be checked out by a parent or legal guardian.
- Pick-up tags are required for Nursery, Preschool, and Elementary check-out.
